NO TIME TO READ?

Reading is a skill, and it gets better with practice. Research shows that children who read as little as 30 minutes a day are likely to become good readers.

Here are some tips from parents on how they squeeze reading into a busy day:

- ◆ *Read at breakfast.* Since many families don't eat at the same time, parents can read to their children or visa versa.
- ◆ *During a drive.* Have your child read to you from their library book, a magazine, or e-reader. This can help pass time for longer trips.
- ◆ *Bath Time Story.* If this comes just before bed, it eliminates the time spent reading in their bed.
- ◆ *Give up a little TV time.* Show your children that reading with them is a priority. It will be worth the time!
